1. Registered or eligible for registration (without restrictions) with the Medical Board of Australia as a Specialist Obstetrician and Gynaecologist.
2. Demonstrated recent clinical experience in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the role delineation of the service.
3. Demonstrated ability to work effectively and collegially as part of a multidisciplinary team and provide leadership of a team.
4. Demonstrated effective clinical communication through the use of information technology and written, verbal and interpersonal skills.
5. Demonstrated commitment to teaching, continuing education, research and quality improvement.
6. Availability to participate in an on-call roster (in addition to regular rostered work consistent with a 0.8FTE position) and to respond on site within a reasonable time.
7. Commitment to provide both obstetric and gynaecological inpatient and outpatient care. Clinic locations will be in both Port Macquarie and Kempsey Hospitals.
