- Certificate IV (or higher) in Child Youth and Family Intervention or equivalent qualification or willingness and ability to obtain
- You will be required to complete a Child Safety and Personal Screening Check and Criminal record check
- Hold or are willing to obtain a Blue Card, Yellow Card, Drivers Licence, First Aid and CPR. Be Job Ready - apply for a Blue Card via www.qld.gov.au/bluecard
