- Bachelor of Social Work qualification is preferred (however other degree level qualification in the field may be assessed as meeting the mandatory requirements and/or significant experience in the sector may also meet requirements on a case by case basis)
- A knowledge and understanding of the drivers/causes of family violence and child and family vulnerability, as well as the child and family services and/or broader social services sector and their fundamental practices and theories is required.
- An understanding of the gendered nature of family violence, the drivers and causes of family violence and feminist, intersectionality and human rights frameworks pertaining to adults and children
- Experience in family violence service or transferrable experience from other sectors including but not limited to child protection, child, youth and family services and homelessness.
- New graduate Social Workers also encouraged to apply.
- High level interpersonal skills, written and verbal communication skills, ability to work both in a team and autonomously
- Working with children check and police check are essential for these roles.
